

## **Upon Arrival at US Flight Academy**

When you arrive at our academy, there will be an orientation including the flight school's facilities, rules and regulations. You are expected to follow the rules of our academy and obey the laws of our country, the state of Texas, and the local authorities. Our Admission Staff will collect your documents, collect the monies due upon your arrival, assist you with the additional paperwork and other details that need to be completed, and give you an orientation.

### Housing provided by US Flight Academy

All students living in apartments provided by US Flight Academy will abide by the rules and regulations of the apartment complex. Once you are assigned an apartment, we are required to provide the apartment management with a copy of your I-20 and passport. Apartments will be furnished to a basic level. It will be the student's responsibility to furnish anything extra. An apartment inventory list is given below.

*Note: no alcoholic beverages of any kind can be consumed in or on USFA sponsored housing or property at any time. You are here to study and to train to be a pilot in a safety first environment.*

- Toaster
